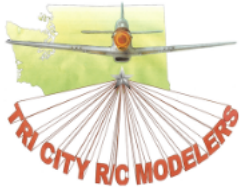

## FLYING SITE SAFETY RULES

1. All Academy of Model Aeronautics National Model Aircraft Safety Code rules must be followed, as posted on shelter.
2. All Club members must read and comply with the AMA Members Safety Program Handbook for all categories of model aircraft flight. The handbook can be found at: <https://www.modelaircraft.org/sites/default/files/documents/100.pdf>
3. It is recommended that members use a spotter, if someone is available.
4. Children shall not be permitted beyond the spectator area unless under the direct supervision of an adult or under flight instruction. The spectator area is limited from the south side perimeter fence to midway between the shelter and the starting tables.
5. Taxiing is not allowed in the pit area.
6. Helicopter/rotor wing flights are allowed (see TCRCM Flying Site Safety and Security Program for cooperative communication guidelines).
7. Sailplane high start lines are to run parallel to active runway.

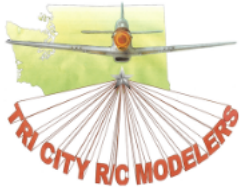

## FLYING SITE OPERATIONAL RULES

1. Only pilots, spotters and assistants are allowed beyond the pit area-pilot area fence during field use.
2. When multiple pilots are flying they should stand on the pilot line defined by the pilot stations. This is to avoid blocking another pilot's view of the runway.
3. Pilots should avoid standing on taxiways while flying.
4. Pilots shall make appropriate announcement when taking off, landing, or emergency situations.
5. All internal combustion engine powered models must be facing the runway for engine start and engine run up.
6. Pilots performing engine run up must be behind the line defined by the spinning blade (meat cleaver).
7. Mufflers are required on all internal combustion engine powered models.
8. Shelter area is reserved for operations or eating during events.
9. Fliers operating models must have their AMA membership cards with them and readily available.
10. Compliance to these safety rules is the responsibility of each participant.

## EMERGENCY RESPONSE

1. First aid kit is in the mower shed and recommended to be with all fliers in their flight box or vehicle.

  - 3) Field Coordinates - 46.355 Longitude / 119.354 Latitude
  - 4) Field Site Address - 5001 Beardsley Road, Richland Washington, 99354

In the event of an emergency, a volunteer will proceed to the intersection of 240 and Beardsley road to direct emergency responders to the flying site.

The flying site entrance gates shall not be blocked by parked vehicles. These gates must be available at all times for emergency access.
